

Amsterdam, Paris, & London

May 15 – 27, 2017

Travel Itinerary

Monday – Depart USA for Amsterdam, Netherlands! Overnight flight (meals included).

Tuesday – Day 1: Amsterdam, Netherland

Upon arrival we are met and transported to our hotel. The rest of the day is “at your leisure” to explore the neighborhood. This evening enjoy a welcome reception and orientation followed by dinner at a local restaurant (not included in the package).

Wednesday – Day 2: Amsterdam, Netherland Black Heritage Tour

After breakfast, We will meet our Tour Guide Ms. Jennifer Tosch, Founder of Black Heritage Tours at the Dam Square (City Center) where we will learn about the history of Amsterdam and it’s hidden history about the Black presence in Amsterdam from the 17th century forward that’s still visible on National landmarks, canal houses, museums, and more. Some of the locations visited include: The Dutch West India House, buildings with Moor heads, the Mayor’s residence (an Unesco Heritage Site and the home of a founding member of the Dutch slave trade and a 17th century sugar refinery. We will be visiting Amsterdam from the canals. After the tour ends you may wish to continue to explore the city on your own. Places of interest includes Anne Frank House. It is recommended to purchase tickets in advance to avoid long lines. Tip: If online tickets are sold out log in at exactly 10:00am and the museum will release some additional tickets. Other favorite museums to visit Hermitage Museum, Amsterdam Museum and the Rijksmuseum where Jennifer Tosch has a private tour of the Black presence in Dutch art. Dinner at a local restaurant (not included in the package). After dinner take a stroll through the notorious “Red Light District.” Jazz lovers can listen to jazz at local venues.

Thursday – Day 3: After breakfast, we will take the open top double decker bus (cost: \$24.00) at Central Station and explore Amsterdam at our own pace or, for those who would like, take a two hour train ride through Holland’s open fields, crisscross with canals and windmills to Brussels, capital of Belgium, and take in Brussels’s must-see sights and cultural delights on a hop-on hop-off sightseeing tour. Tonight’s farewell dinner in a local restaurant (not included in the package).

Friday – Day 4: After breakfast We will depart for Paris “The City of Lights” via 1st class train accommodations. After checking in to our hotel the rest of the day is at your leisure to explore the neighborhood. Dinner will be at a local restaurant (not included in the package). After dinner stroll the elegant areas of Place de la Concorde... Avenue des Champs-Elysees... Avenue Foch... Palais Garnier Opera... and the exciting Vendome Plaza (where the most prestigious jewelers are represented... and beautiful St. Honore’ Street (aka rue du Fauborg Saint Honore’ — cited as one of the most fashionable streets in the world and home to many famous fashion designers. For those interested in night time entertainment, we can offer suggestions of places to visit including jazz, dance clubs, R&B, and Opera concerts. The renowned Lionel Hampton Jazz Club is a popular Paris Landmark located at the Meridien Hotel.

Saturday – Day 5: After breakfast, the morning presents the opportunity to discover the world famous Palais du Louvre Museum. The Louvre is open every day except Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Ticket price starts at \$16.00 per person. Skip the Line Entrance Access to the Louvre Museum starts at \$32.00 per person; both are self-guided tours. There are no fewer than 15 cafes, restaurants and take-away outlets throughout the Louvre, the Carrousel, and Tuileries Garden. Make sure to take a stroll through the Gardens. Later, enjoy shopping at the Galeries Lafayette and other local boutiques. Dinner at a local restaurant (not included in the package).

Sunday – Day 6: After breakfast, those wishing to attend church services have a choice of two American Churches: The American Church and the American Cathedral. Also Notre Dame Cathedral Paris has (Catholic) mass services. Later we will explore more of Paris... Sacre Couer... Montmarte... African Musee Dapper Museum and other sites of interest. Dinner at local restaurant (not included in the package)

Monday – Day 7: After breakfast, leisure day to explore Paris on your own. Afternoon Tea at Angelina is a must. It is one of the grandest Parisian tea salons in Paris.

Tuesday – Day 8: After breakfast, continue to enjoy the City of Paris. Our farewell dinner will be at the Eiffel Tower where we will have a breath-taking view of Paris. After dinner we will enjoy an hour cruise on the River Seine to rediscover the full splendor of Paris.

Wednesday – Day 9: Early breakfast, check-out. Today we transfer to the Gare Du Nord train station for our trip from Paris to London via the Chunnel, the 31 mile long under water tunnel, considered one of the “Seven Wonders of the Modern World.” The (Eurostar) 1st class Rail to London – 2 hours 55 minutes. After check-in enjoy the day at leisure to explore London, the capital of the United Kingdom and one of the world’s premier cities. Some main attractions include the British Museum, The Tower of London, London Eye, Piccadilly Square or shop for souvenirs at the world famous Harrods department store and Selfridge Department store. Dinner at a local restaurant (not included in package).

Thursday – Day 10: After breakfast, we will take a half day city tour of London. The tour begins with a panoramic drive around Parliament Square to see the magnificent Westminster Abbey where Prince Williams and Kate Middleton were married. See the Royal Albert Hall, & Albert Memorial, White Hall, Downing Street, the House of Parliament, the London Eye, and Big Ben. Continue to St. James Park and Buckingham Palace to see the colorful ceremony of changing of the Guards. The changing of the Guard is subject to occurrence. If it is not taking place, the tour will visit the Horse Guards Parade. London is well known for its “Theatre District.” Go on line to www.londonshows.cwc.net to check what’s currently playing in London.

Friday – Day 11 : After breakfast, leisure time to explore the sights of London. Oxford University is an hour away from London by train for those who may be interested in exploring Oxford. If you are a jazz lover Ronnie Scott’s Jazz Club is the place to be!

Saturday-Day 12: Early breakfast, check-out and transfer to the airport. Return to the United States.
